## WHAT IS THE SATURDAY WORKSHOP SERIES?

The Apollo Theater Academy Saturday Workshop Series teaches high school students about careers in technical stage production. Participants learn lighting design, audio engineering, set design and prop creation.

In the Saturday Workshop Series, students get to work with members of the Apollo Theater's production crew, while learning what it takes to put on a live theatrical production. The Saturday Workshop Series provides students with the necessary skills and knowledge to explore technical careers in the arts and entertainment industries.

The Saturday Workshop Series is open to NYC High School Students grades 9 –12. Spring 2012 classes take place over 12 weeks, Saturdays beginning March 3 through May 19, from 11:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. The Saturday Workshop Series is a free program.

## WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS?

- All participants are required to attend an orientation for the program on Wednesday, February 29, 2012.
- All participants must be high school students with a valid school ID, school record/schedule, or report card.
- All participants must be available and commit to attending each Saturday from March 3 through May 19.
- All participants should have an interest in behind-the-scenes careers in the arts, theater, or entertainment industry.
